August 7, 1946 - September 6, 2014

Peter Cooper Oppenheimer, 68, of Weaverville passed away after severe trauma sustained from a biking accident, on Saturday September 6, 2014 at the Memorial Campus of Mission Hospital .

Born in Far Rockaway, NY, Peter was the son of Joseph and Diane Spielberg Oppenheimer and brother to Kenneth Oppenheimer and Paula Friedman.

Before settling in Weaverville, NC in 2005, Peter lived with his wife and family in Coral Springs, FL. A veteran of the United States Army and Army Reserves, Peter had a long career as a Commercial Real Estate broker in NY, FL and NC.

An outdoor enthusiast he enjoyed biking, fishing, hiking , swimming, golfing, skiing and most recently RV'ing. He also enjoyed music, woodworking, cooking and philanthropic endeavors in the community. Peter was a member of Congregation Beth HaTephila.

Peter is survived by his wife of 45 years, Janet Oppenheimer; a daughter, Debra Lawrence; two sons, Robert and Aaron Oppenheimer; and four grandchildren, Samantha Lawrence, Ethan Lawrence, Liam Oppenheimer and Ezra Oppenheimer.

A funeral service will be held at 12:30pm on Monday September 8, 2014 at Temple Beth HaTephila, 43 North Liberty Street, Asheville, with Rabbi Batsheva Meiri officiating. Interment will follow at Riverside Cemetery, 53 Birch Street, Asheville.
