



Mr. Walter Ervin Ingle Jr.

July 30, 1938 - January 3, 2015

Walter Ervin Ingle, Jr. died on Saturday, January 3, 2015 at Mission Hospital after a two-year struggle with declining health.

Ervin was born in Buncombe County on July 30, 1938 to the late Walter Ervin Ingle, Sr. and Hazel Garland Ingle. His sister, Barbara Ingle Fowler, preceded him in death.

Ervin graduated from Biltmore High School where he was a member of the baseball, basketball and football teams. He enjoyed staying in touch with classmates throughout the years. He played semi-pro baseball in Virginia for one year. He graduated from Asheville-Buncombe Community College. He served in the United States Air Force. Ervin worked in the finance business for ten years and ended his working years as the golf director for the Hilton Inn. He was a member of Central United Methodist Church and a member of Ashler Masonic Lodge 0373, Deep Gap, North Carolina.

Ervin was a quiet, reserved, and private individual who was dedicated to his family. He loved to cook and always enjoyed getting together with family. He had a generous heart and enjoyed quietly helping other people. Ervin found great pleasure in long rides on the Blue Ridge Parkway and the back roads of Western North Carolina. He was an avid reader and spent a great deal of time feeding the birds in his own back yard.

He is survived by his wife of fifty years, Mary Margaret Ingle; his daughter, Kimberly Ingle Everette; son-in-law, William Brad Everette; granddaughter, Lillian Mae Everette; one sister, Wilma Reece; one aunt, Virginia Ingle; and several nieces and nephews.
