



Mr. Albert M. Caflisch

January 11, 1923 - November 23, 2016

Albert M. Caflisch, 93, passed away on Wednesday November 23, 2016.

Albert was born in Union City, PA, a short distance from Erie. He was preceded in death by his wife, Anne Caflisch; a brother Raymond; and a sister, Mary Dickson of Waterford, PA. Mr. Caflisch is survived by his daughters, Ruth "Mickie" Bass and her husband, Richard, of Asheville, and Terri Leszczyszyn and her husband, Stephen, of Irmo, SC; two granddaughters; a great grandson; and nieces and nephews.

He served in the US Navy in the Pacific during World War II and after his service he wanted to become an accountant, so he entered the University of South Carolina making the Dean's List, and upon graduation became an Internal Revenue Agent in Columbia, SC. His entire working career was with the IRS. In time he was promoted and sent to IRS Headquarters in Washington, DC to become Branch Chief of Tax Law Technical Review Division for Co-ops. He retired from that position in 1981. Upon retirement, he and his wife relocated to Asheville from Bethesda, MD in 1982.

He was a 32nd degree Mason and achieved lifetime membership many years ago after reaching 50 years of service within the Masonic Blue Lodge of Richland County, SC.
