Anne M. Fowler, 89, of Asheville, NC, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on August 26, 2025, at 3:25 p.m. while in the care of The Laurels of Summit Ridge.

She was born on June 29, 1936, in Kreutzthal, Bavaria, Germany, to the late Max and Anna Faerber. She was also preceded in death by her sisters, Hilda and Gertrud, and by her grandson, Andrew King.

A lifelong learner, she was an avid reader with a deep passion for history, and she instilled her love of education in both her children and her grandchild. Anne was also known for her talents in the kitchen. An accomplished cook and baker, she expressed her love through food, leaving lasting impressions on all who gathered at her table.

Throughout Daniel's corporate career, the couple moved eight times, and

Anne managed each transition with extraordinary care. She always ensured that the right home, the right schools, and every detail in between had been addressed. She had a gift for planning and foresight, often described as being able to “see around the corner,” which made her the steady heart of her family.
