Dr. Anne Elizabeth Sagberg, 93, of Asheville died Saturday, June 2, 2012 at the Western North Carolina Baptist Home. A native of Norway, she was the youngest daughter of the late Paul and Ragna Holt Sagberg. She was preceded in death by one sister and two brothers.

Dr. Sagberg graduated with a medical degree from the University of Oslo. She relocated from Oslo to Durham, NC to further her studies in psychiatry at Duke University. After medical school, she accepted a position at Highland Hospital in Asheville where she remained until her retirement. She loved the mountains and Asheville.

Always passionate about her work, Anne also enjoyed reading, traveling and most of all her dogs. She was full of life, had a big heart and was always willing to lend a hand to anyone in need.
