Astral Benjamin Freeman of Asheville entered eternity on January 21, 2024. He was born and raised in Tampa, FL. He is survived by his parents, Susan and Dr. Tom Freeman, of Tampa and Asheville, siblings Danny Freeman of San Francisco and Jon-Delia of Asheville, and grandmothers Lea and Carolynn of Prairie Village, KS.

He was a creative spirit in everything he touched, from painting to poetry. As a musician, he played drums in America's Youngest Jazz Band, including three years at New Orleans Jazz Fest. He served as section leader of the Hillsborough High School Big Red Band and was rhythmically gifted.

He offered his unique inner experiences to others through the language of poetry, and published his first book, "Present Moment Poetry." He co-founded the Asheville Alive Poets Society and performed there often.

He shared himself with people in recovery as a Peer Support Specialist at Seek Healing of Asheville.

Astral's sensitivity, empathy, and insight were abundant and frequently experienced by those who knew and loved him. Astral listened to others with a compassionate ear. He derived meaning and joy from supporting others, and did everything he could to make the world a more connected and loving place. His family and friends were blessed by his intense and beautiful inner light. He will be missed and in our hearts forever.

Funeral services are at Congregation Beth HaTephila with burial at Riverside Cemetery, with arrangements by Morris Funeral Home.
