Barbara Ann (Smith) Kruszewski, 84, of Asheville passed away peacefully on Monday, May 18, 2026 at her residence.

Barbara received a Bachelors of Science degree in Home Economics from Carson Newman University in TN. She then worked as a Food Editor for the Washington Post for 3 years. Additionally she received a Masters Degree in Social Work from Catholic University in Washington, DC.

Following her time with the government, she worked for a local agency to counsel hospital and police employees. She also did pro bono work for All
