



Dr. Basil Goldman

April 7, 1931 - July 19, 2014

Dr. Basil A. Goldman, 83 of Jacksonville, FL and Mills River, NC passed away on July 19, 2014. A native of New Jersey, he was a graduate of Weequahic High School in Newark, received his bachelors degree in Social Studies with a minor in physical education and a masters degree in Administration from Montclair State College and his Doctorate in Guidance and Psychology from Rutgers University.

In 1975, Dr. Goldman received the Distinguished Service Award in recognition of Outstanding Contributions for Education from the Alumni Association of the Graduate School of Education of Rutgers University. He served as president of the New Jersey Association of Pupil Personnel Administrators from 1989-1990 and as president of the Rutgers Chapter of Phi Delta Kappa from 1967-1968. After a career spanning 36 1/2 years, he retired in 1991. He was a veteran of the Korean War.

Dr. Goldman was preceded in death by his son, Robert A. Goldman and a sister, Jean Goldman. He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Irma Edelstein Goldman; his daughter, Amy Levinson and her husband, Don; grandson, Ben Robert Levinson; sister, Esther Greenberg and her husband, Alfred and a brother, Shep Goldman and his wife, Jean.
