



Mr. Carl Boardman Cobb

March 16, 1921 - April 26, 2011

Carl Boardman Cobb, 90, of Asheville died Tuesday, April 26, 2011 following an extended illness. Born March 16, 1921 in Cleveland, Ohio, he was son of the late Richard Henry Cobb, Sr. and Edith Boardman Cobb. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Richard Henry Cobb, Jr.

Carl served his country in the US Army; he was at the Normandy Invasion, D-Day +3 as a First Lieutenant. He was awarded the Bronze Star and Purple Heart for heroism.

While in Cleveland, Carl had been active in The American Furniture Collectors and The Western Reserve Historical Society. He was a long-time member of The County Club in Pepper Pike, Ohio, and was a member of The Walden Golf and Tennis Club in Aurora, Ohio and The Country Club of Asheville. He traveled extensively, enjoyed genealogy, collecting antiques and attending the Cleveland Symphony. He was an avid tennis player but mostly, he just loved his family.

His survivors include his wife, Susan Ann Bitner Cobb and son, Jeffrey Bitner Cobb both of Asheville.

A memorial service is planned for the summer in Cleveland, Ohio.
