Carol Burgeois Hoyle, 87, of Asheville died Monday, May 10, 2010 at Emerald Ridge Health Care. A native of New Orleans, LA she was daughter of the late Lionel John and Enola Folse Bourgeois. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Frank W. Hoyle in 1976, two brothers, Lionel J. Bourgeois and Thomas Bourgeois, and three sisters, Madeline B. 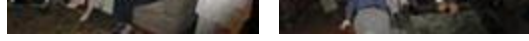
