



Mrs. Catherine Fulton Rosselet

July 12, 1918 - April 5, 2011

Mary Catherine Rosselet (Fulton), of Asheville, died peacefully in her home on April 5, 2011. Born in Orange Beach, Alabama in 1918, the daughter of the late George and Elvira Fulton, she was preceded in death by her husband, Samuel David Rosselet, as well as her two brothers George and William.

Catherine grew up in Pittsburgh, PA where she completed her undergraduate degree in music at Carnegie Mellon University. She went on to teach at a school for blind students, and earn a masters degree in Christian Education at Eastern Baptist Seminary.

In preparation for work overseas, she moved to Quebec, Canada to work with leaders in the French churches there. It was while living in Montreal that she met her husband, Samuel. The family relocated to Asheville in the summer of 1969.

A lifelong educator, she taught music, English, French, and Latin at schools at the elementary and secondary level in Canada and the States. Always talented, artistic, and creative, she took up painting in the 1990s and went on to produce many types of artwork.

A member of the Asheville Bible Church, she taught Sunday school at the Bible Church and at Kenilworth Presbyterian.

Catherine is survived by her son Elliott, his wife Donna, and their sons Wesley and Ian of Hanover PA; her son Alan, his wife Elizabeth, and their sons Andrew and James of Toronto, Ontario; and sister-in-law Kathleen, wife of her (now deceased) twin brother George, of Newville PA.

The family extends its heartfelt appreciation to the caregivers of Home Instead, who stayed with Catherine in her home once she lost her independence, and to the doctors and nurses of Care Partners Palliative and Hospice services who treated our mother.

A funeral service will be held 1:30 PM, Monday, April 11, 2011, in the chapel of Morris Funeral Home, 304 Merrimon Avenue, with Pastor Pat Leahy officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service, and a reception at the family home will follow the service. Private entombment will be held at Lewis Memorial Park.
