



Mrs. Charlene Elliott Tomlin

November 1, 1951 - May 4, 2017

Charlene Elliott Tomlin, age 65 passed away the 4th of May, 2017 after battling lung cancer for over a year. Born November 1st, 1951 in Asheville, North Carolina, she was the daughter of the late Emma E. Elliott. She graduated from Asheville High School (formally Lee Edwards High School) in 1970. After graduation, she went to work at the Buncombe County Tax Office where she worked for 16 years before retiring to be a stay at home mom. While in high school, she was a member of Beta Sigma Phi Sorority.

In 1979, she married Tom Tomlin and in 1982 their daughter was born and in 1984 their son was born. As their children were in elementary school, she joined the PTO at their schools and attended all their school functions and did so through high school. In 1999, she started working in the concessions stand at Asheville High School and was concession co-manager for 14 years before retiring in the spring of 2013. She was an avid NASCAR fan who seldom missed watching the races on Sunday.

She is survived by her husband Tom Tomlin; their daughter, Judy T. Jackson and her husband Jason; a son Gregory Tomlin and wife Samantha who is expecting their second child; a granddaughter Charlotte Tomlin; a step son, David Tomlin; and two step grandchildren, Chelsea and Isaiah Jackson.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, May 8th at 2:00pm at Morris Funeral

Home, 304 Merrimon Ave, Asheville, NC 28801 with Pastor Roger Boone of Cedar Hill Free Will Baptist Church officiating. The burial will follow at Lewis Memorial Park. Pall bearers will be Jim Williams, John Williams, Tony Gosnell, Charlie Hyland, Mike Jarvis and Isaiah Jackson.
