Charles David "Bogie" Bogart, II of Whittier died Wednesday, August 10, 2011 after a lengthy battle with congestive heart failure and diabetes. Born in 1937, he was a native of Evansville, Indiana, son of the late Charles David and Elizabeth Carr Bogart. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his sister, Bettye Joyce Childers.

Mr. Bogart was a graduate of Georgetown College in Kentucky, where he co-captained the football team. He was a longtime employee of Shoney's, Inc., retiring as division Vice President of Lee's Famous Recipe Restaurants.

He will be remembered by his friends and loved ones as a man of great humor, courage and strength.

Survivors include his wife and college sweetheart, Susan; two daughters, Karen Ross of Dallas, TX and Kimberly Bogart of Crestview Hills, KY; three grandchildren, Joshua Zurborg, Channing Creager and Samuel Ross; niece, Mary Lou Altuna; nephew, Russell Childers and sister-in-law, Polly Knapp and her husband, Bob.
