Charles W. Epley, of Asheville died Thursday, November 17, 2011 at John F. Keever Jr. Solace Center at the age of 80. A native of McDowell County, he lived most of his life in Buncombe County and was son of the late Edwin E. and Gertrude Epley. He was also preceded in death by his sister, Mary Evelyn Brown of Chicago, IL and his aunt, Olive W. Lewis of Asheville.

Mr. Epley was a graduate of Lee Edwards High School, Mars Hill College and University of NC-Chapel Hill. A North Korean Veteran of the US Army, he retired in 1985 from Atkins Harper Lumber Company after 28 years of service. After his retirement he spent many years in volunteer service with the WNC Slavic Ministries and Habitat for Humanity. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Asheville and a member of the Fellowship Sunday School Class.
