Constance M. Dula, 84, of Fletcher died Friday, April 1, 2011 at her residence. A native of Montgomery, Alabama, she was the daughter of the late Lawrence John and Alma Parker Montgomery. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 61 years, Thomas C. Dula in September, 2008.

Mrs. Dula graduated from St. Joseph's academy in Jacksonville, Fl., going on to major in business administration at Auburn University.

Having a lifelong passion for the arts, her promising dancing career ended when she contracted polio at the age of 16. She went on to study music, sang in a trio and played at the U.S.O. She opened a dance studio in Jacksonville, Florida and later, as an accomplished seamstress; she opened a fabric and quilting store in Weaverville, NC, and one in Biltmore Village.

She was an active member of St. Barnabas Roman Catholic Church. She was previously a member at St. Eugene's Catholic Church.

Her survivors include her children, Thomas C. Dula, III, James M. Dula, John H. Dula, Robert B. Dula, Constance A. Dula, Carolyn O'Gorman, William E. Dula, Elizabeth J. Dula and Kenneth M. Dula; 14 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held 11:00 AM, Saturday, April 16, 2011 at St. Barnabas Roman Catholic Church, 109 Crescenthill Drive, Arden, NC with Father Adrian Porras officiating.
