



## Cuyler Trussell DuPree

August 9, 1948 - October 14, 2022

Cuyler Trussell Dupree of Asheville, North Carolina, passed away on October 14, 2022, at the age of 74. Cuyler was born in Athens, Georgia in 1948. Surviving him is his son, Dan Hughes DuPree, IV, his daughter-in-law, Jessica Potts DuPree and his granddaughter, Jeannie Rose DuPree of Peachtree Corners, Georgia. Also surviving is his sister, Katherine DuPree Potter of Montrose, Georgia.

Family members who preceded him in death are his father, Dan Hughes DuPree, Jr., his mother, LaGrange Trussell DuPree, and his brother, Dan Hughes DuPree, III of Athens.

Cuyler was a graduate of North Georgia College, Dahlonega in 1970 with a bachelor's degree in Psychology. He worked for 30 years for the United States Social Security Administration in Georgia, South Carolina, and North Carolina. He settled in Asheville, North Carolina and was a member of Grace Episcopal Church. He was a faithful servant on the church vestry and altar guild. Though he had many interests, perhaps one of Cuyler's greatest passions was the University of Georgia Bulldogs, a special lifelong enthusiasm that he shared with his son.

A service for Cuyler will be held on Tuesday, October 25, 2022 at 11 a.m. at Grace Episcopal Church, 871 Merrimon Ave. Asheville, NC 28804.
