Dr. Dale F. Walker was born on July 27, 1938 and dies on December 13, 2025. Dale was born in Lincoln, IL. He attended grammar and high school in St. Elmo, IL and graduated from the University of Southern Illinois, from Drew Theological Seminary in New Jersey and from Cornell University where he studied Indonesian and linguistics.

Dale and Alice lived in Indonesia for 30 years and in Poland. In Indonesia, Dale made a Concordance from the Indonesian Bible and taught at several theological schools. Dale was also an adjunct professor at Asbury Seminary for 15 years.
