



## Mr. David McKenzie Clark

August 2, 1922 - May 9, 2010

David McKenzie Clark, 87, of Givens Estates, Asheville, NC died Sunday, May 9, 2010 after a long illness. A native of Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina, he was son of the late Alexander Lillington and Clara Belle Foy Clark. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by five siblings.

After his first year at NC State University, Mr. Clark joined the US Army Air Corp. He was a Glider Pilot serving in the invasion of Normandy on D-Day, June 6, 1944.

Mr. Clark graduated with a degree in Textile Engineering from NC State University in Raleigh, NC. He began his textile career with Chatham Mfg. Co. in Elkin, NC before retiring from Dow Chemical/BASF in Williamsburg, VA.

He was an active member of Williamsburg United Methodist Church in Williamsburg, VA and Central United Methodist Church in Asheville, NC.
