August 8, 1929 - November 9, 2017

Donald Ernest Wick, of Asheville North Carolina, went home to his heavenly father on Thursday November 9, 2017 at his home of 57 years. He was 88 years old.

Surviving Don is his loving wife of 60 years, Virginia Wick. His two sons, Lamar Wick, of Asheville, and William and Stephanie Wick of Hendersonville. Don was proud of his six grandchildren, Conner, Nathan, Jacob, Kendall, Liam and Annalisa that he loved more than anything and treasured the time he spent with them. He took great care of his family, always wanting them happy.

Don was a veteran of the Korean War, serving proudly with the United States Marine Corp. Since 1960, he was an active member and former deacon of Biltmore Baptist Church. Don touched many people's lives and is affectionately known to many as Daddy Wick, Boppa, and "the old man". He will be remembered for his good sense of humor and loving spirit.
