Doris Osborne Hensley, 91, formerly of Asheville died Monday, August 1, 2010 in Satsuma, FL, at the residence of her daughter, Anne Farren, following a period of declining health. A native of Brevard, NC she was born November 13, 1918 the daughter of the late Camuel Brooks and Ella Monroe Osborne. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Herbert Guy Hensley and two brothers, William Keith Osborne and Cameron B. Osborne.

The family moved to Asheville when she was a small child.
