



## Dorothy Cramer Maitland

February 18, 1930 - September 24, 2022

Dorothy Cramer Maitland “Dorie” died peacefully Saturday, September 24th at her residence at Deerfield in Asheville, NC. She was 92.

Dorothy was born February 18, 1930, in Hartford, Connecticut, spending her childhood years in Wethersfield. Her lovely New England home on Center Street still stands today. In 1948, she graduated valedictorian from her high school class. She graduated from Connecticut College in 1952 with a degree in American History.

She met Alexander Maitland, III while in nursing school at Yale University. They married in 1955. Before moving to Asheville in 1962, the Maitlands lived in Rochester, NY, Baumholder, Germany and St. Louis, MO. Mrs. Maitland was an elementary school teacher during the early years of her marriage and had many fond memories of her students and her teaching experience. In Asheville, Mrs. Maitland was active as a volunteer and substitute teacher at St. Genevieve’s/Gibbons Hall School, The Junior League of Asheville and the Women’s Medical Auxiliary.

Mrs. Maitland returned to complete her Nursing Degree at AB Tech in 1975 and worked for many years in the medical field. She went on to become a Certified Diabetes Educator and loved helping her patients better manage their disease.

Dr. and Mrs. Maitland retired in 1998 and spent time traveling and enjoying friends and family. Most of all, they loved spending time at Kiawah Island in South Carolina.

The Maitlands were members of Trinity Episcopal Church.

Mrs. Maitland is preceded in death by her parents, Brig. General and Mrs. Kenneth (Ruth) Cramer, her beloved older sister, Margaret "Peggy" C. Gladney and her husband, Dr. Alexander Maitland, III. She is survived by two children and four grandchildren.

A memorial service to honor her life will be held on November 5th @ 11:30am at St. Giles Chapel on the Deerfield Campus.
