Ed Duncan, of Asheville, was born on December 10, 1930, and he passed away at his home on Tuesday, April 26, 2022.

He was a native of Hohenwald, Tennessee, and the son of the late Orlando Pierce Duncan and Lydia Duncan. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Lois Irene Patton, and his brother, Elvin Ward Duncan. A graduate of the class of 1947, from Lewis County High School. Mr. Duncan entered the United States Air Force where he served in the Far East during the Korean War.
