Ann Jacks Perkins, 64, of Asheville died Friday, September 5, 2014. A native of Forsyth County, she was the daughter of the late Rev. Ralph and Miriam Wilson Jacks. A 1968 graduate of Valdese High School, she attended Phiffer University and received her EMS Degree for Asheville Buncombe Community Technical College. Ann was a loving wife, mother, and a friend to all, she never knew a stranger.

Ann worked at Memorial Mission Hospital for over 30 years working in several departments including the Radiology Department and volunteered at both Memorial and St. Joseph Campus's and several retirement communities playing the piano in the lobbies. She was also a volunteer at the Asheville Chamber of Commerce. She was an avid photographer and shared her many pictures through her postcards and note cards. Of all the things Ann enjoyed, playing organ and piano at Asbury Memorial United Methodist Church, where she was a member and Music Director for 37 years, was her favorite.

She was preceded in death by her husband, James Perkins who died in 2001. She is survived by her daughter, Julia Boyd and her husband Jimmy of Asheville; sister, Rosalynde Robertson and her husband Walter of Virgilina, VA; and a niece, Laura Robertson of Raleigh, NC.
