January 24, 1928 - December 4, 2013

Eric Elbert Heuermann, Jr. age 85, died peacefully December 4, 2013 at the home of his daughter Lana Heuermann and her husband Ralph Thomas in Asheville, NC. The son of Eric Heuermann and Beryl Whitney Heuermann, he was born in San Francisco January 24, 1928. In 1945 he joined the US Marine Corps upon graduation from Tamalpais School for Boys in San Rafael, CA. After serving in China, he earned his BA from Colgate University. He is survived by his first wife Patricia Calhoun and their children Beryl Lee, William Whitney, Lana Amanda, and Dilwara Linda. He is also survived by his brother, William Whitney Heuermann, three sons-in-law, one daughter-in-law, fourteen grandchildren, six great grandchildren and his former wife Carol Biggers. His ashes will be placed in the family mausoleum in Rocklin, California. A private memorial service will be held and a public celebration of life will be held at a later date.
