March 11, 1946 - August 1, 2022

Frederick Irwin Silverman, age 76, of Asheville, died on Monday 1 August 2022, at home, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on 11 March 1946, in Miami, FL, and was the son of the late Peter and Ruth Silverman. Dr. Silverman earned his undergraduate degree from Duke University and went on to study and graduate from Meharry Medical College and Emory University earning his post-doctorate in Prosthodontics. His waterfall created spaces for an expansive back deck with a fire pit, where all enjoyed many hours together creating memories. He was truly loved and will be deeply missed.

In addition to his loving and devoted wife, Janise Rose Silverman, Rick leaves behind, two daughters; Jessica and Monica, and a grandson, Austin; a sister-in-law, Shelly Rose Krepistman, and her husband, Adam, and three loving
