Garland C. Pryor, 67 of Asheville passed away Friday September 9, 2016 at Mission Hospital of Asheville. Garland was born in Buena Vista, VA on September 29, 1948 to Calvin Pryor and Ruby Chittum Pryor-Stinett. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his step-father Samuel Stinett. He is survived by one son, Adam Pryor; one sister, Wanda Pope; and two nephews, Todd and Russel Pope. Garland lived in Advance, NC near Winston-Salem from 1986 to 2015 where he owned his own business, Realty Courier Service. In 2015, Garland moved to Asheville to be closer to his son.
