Georgina Royer Bruce, 95, of Givens Highland Farms Community, Black Mountain, died March 23rd, 2026.

A native of Waynesboro, PA, Georgina was the daughter of the late George Alfred Royer and Mary Meyers Royer. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert Gunning Bruce, in 1996. She was a graduate of Waynesboro, PA, High School and Wilson College, Chambersburg, PA.

Before her marriage, Georgi worked in Washington, DC, for the Department of Defense and afterwards for Fairchild Aircraft in Hagerstown, MD. After raising her family in VA, MD, OR, and NC during her husband's career in the National Park Service, she obtained her Real Estate Broker's license and also worked as a tax consultant for H&R Block. Georgi volunteered for Meals on Wheels for 15 years in its early days and for over 2000

hours at St. Joseph's Hospital. She also volunteered in many capacities for Grace Episcopal Church.

She is survived by daughters Suzy Hedden (Jimmy) of Leicester, Sally Withers (David) of Swannanoa and son Bill Bruce (Sue) of Charlotte. Seven grandchildren, Vanessa Rhodarmer (Ben), Matthew Hedden (Kellyn), Caleb Hedden (Chelsea), Mary Bates (Kevin), Eleanor Kumar (Aditya), Katherine, and Maggie Bruce survive her as well as great-grandchildren Bryce and Bria Rhodarmer, Wyatt, Wade, Wells, and Parker Hedden, Katie, and Liam Bates.

A family memorial service will be held at a later date at First Christian Church, Black Mountain, with the Rev. Dr. Kevin Bates officiating. Ashes will be interred at the family plot at Cedar Hill Cemetery, Greencastle, PA.
