



## Mr. Gerald Edwin Eisnitz

December 5, 1922 - March 11, 2012

Gerald Eisnitz, 89, beloved father and grandfather, died March 11, 2012, after a brief illness. Born in New York City in 1922, he lived for many years in New Jersey and served in the US Army Air Corps during World War II. He became a successful businessman and owned several women's apparel stores in New Jersey. He retired to Asheville in 1996 and enjoyed residing in the beautiful mountain community.

He overcame polio and later survived post-polio syndrome. In 2008, he moved to the Brooks Howell Home to maintain his independence, where he made many caring friends.

He will be deeply missed by his loving family - daughters, Gail Eisnitz, of Asheville, and Lisa Wolff of Hummelstown, Pa.; son-in-law, Robert Wolff; and his pride and joy, granddaughters, Jessica and Amanda Wolff.
