



The Rev. Harold Lee Beaumont

June 21, 1914 - December 5, 2009

The Reverend Harold Lee Beaumont of Asheville NC entered his heavenly home on December 5, 2009. Born in Mahanoy City, PA in 1914, the son of Abram Lee and Mary (Jones) Beaumont, he received his BA from Albright College in Reading PA and his Masters from Union Theological Seminary in NY. Later, on the GI Bill, he completed work on his doctorate at NYU.

Rev. Beaumont served the New York Conference of the United Methodist Church for 40 years with parishes on Long Island, in Queens, Brooklyn and Westchester County. After retirement, he served a number of interim pastorates in VT and NC. He was a US Army Chaplain during both World War II and Korea.

Rev. Beaumont is survived by Margaret Jackson Beaumont, his wife of 70 years, and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a brother, Ronald, and sister, Mae Wertz, both of Broomall, PA.

A graveside service was held on Wed. Dec 9th at Calvary Episcopal cemetery in Fletcher. A memorial service is being planned for Sat. Dec 19th at 2:00 p.m., at the Chapel of Givens Estates in Asheville. Funeral arrangements are through the Morris Funeral Home of Asheville. Rev. Beaumont was well suited for his profession as a minister. He had a special gift of being able to communicate with people - young and old, rich and poor, intellectuals and the uneducated. His goal was to make Jesus Christ and his message alive and meaningful. He was also a man of the people. He loved sports, loved to laugh, could tell a good joke and amused people with his interesting stories. He spent his life helping people and for that he was well loved by many. He will be missed.
