September 24, 1926 - December 7, 2011

Jack Orenzow, 85, of Asheville, NC died Wednesday, December 7, 2011 at the Charles George VA Medical Center, Valor Hospice Floor.

A native of Bronx, New York, he was a US Navy Veteran of WWII. Jack spent his early career managing 150 employees of a large food distributor in Long Island, NY. After moving to Asheville, he worked in the family business, The Candle Station, where he was fondly known as Papa Jack. A member of Congregation Beth HaTephila, he served on the board of the Asheville Jewish Community Center where one of his favorite activities was calling Bingo. He was a member of The Veterans of Foreign Wars and Knights of Pythias.

He is survived by his wife Claire Peck Orenzow, daughters, Trudy Vautrin Gould and Helaine Greene both of Asheville; three grandchildren, Dr. Scott Vautrin of St. George, Utah, Rebecca Greene Morphis of Durham, NC and Jenny Greene Rawlings of Weaverville and nine great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held 11:00 AM, Friday, December 9, 2011 at Congregation Beth HaTephila with Rabbi Batsheva H. Meiri and Cantor Debbie Winston officiating. Interment will follow at Riverside Cemetery. The family will receive friends from 7:00 – 8:30 PM, Thursday, December 8, 2011 at Morris Funeral Home, 304 Merrimon Avenue.
