James Edward Chapman, 89, of 11 Country Club Trail died Monday, September 3, 2012 at his residence.

Born in Cross Hill, SC, he was the son of the late Douglas R. Chapman and the late Carrie Young Chapman Leaman. He was also preceded in death by his sister, Sara Shillinglaw.

He was a graduate of Clemson University Class of 1944. He received a degree in mechanical engineering in 1947 after returning to Clemson from service in the United States Army. During World War II he served 3 years in the Army Signal Corps attaining the rank of 1st Lieutenant.

Jimmy began his working career in Sales Engineering, JohnsManville Building Products Division. After 32 years with JohnsManville he retired and became owner and president of Newman Wholesale of Asheville

He was a member and elder of the First Presbyterian Church of Asheville, a former member of the Country Club of Asheville and the Rhododendron Royal Brigade of Guards.

He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and enjoyed cooking and antique collecting and restoration.

Jimmy was married 41 years to his beloved late wife, Reid Stratton Troitino of

Asheville.
