Jane C. Stentz, 90, of Asheville died Saturday, February 11, 2012 at Brooks-Howell Home. Born in Birmingham, AL, she spent her formative years in western North Carolina and Southern California. She was daughter of the late Jephtha Dale and Mary Stuart Chester Stentz and granddaughter of Dr. George R. Stuart, Lake Junaluska.

Jane earned her first masters in Christian Education and Bible from Scarritt College and Vanderbilt University and a M.Ed. in Guidance and Counseling from Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton, FL.

She dedicated her life to serving others, her career spanned from her first missionary term on the faculty of Leonard Theological College in Jabalpur, India to her final position as Director of United Campus Ministries in Boca Raton, Florida. Jane worked constantly in ecumenical endeavors throughout communities to bring ministers, priests and Rabbis together by building bridges of understanding and working together to bring tolerance and peace to communities. By counseling students from all walks of life, regardless of church affiliations, life styles or beliefs, she endeavored to emulate God's unconditional love.

Jane moved to Brooks-Howell Home in January 2004 where she lived a blessed daily life enjoying her friends and community. She is survived by

several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service was held at Brooks-Howell Home.
