



## Mr. Joseph "Joe" Davis Friedman

November 28, 1924 - January 3, 2011

Joseph "Joe" Davis Friedman, 86, of Asheville died Monday, January 3, 2011 at St. Joseph's Hospital. A native of Johnson City, TN he was son of the late, Jack and Maude Davis Friedman.

Joe was a US Army veteran of WWII, where he served as CPL in the CO B 180th Infantry 45th Division. During his service to our country, he received the Good Conduct Medal, European-African Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon, WWII Victory Ribbon and a Purple Heart.

He was a former Owner/Operator of Jewelry Stores in Harlan, KY, Middlesboro, KY and Knoxville, TN. In 1974, Gov. Wendell H. Ford commissioned Joe a Kentucky Col. He was the owner of Factory Carpet Center in Asheville. He was a member and former deacon of First Christian Church.

His survivors include his wife, Linda B. Friedman; three daughters, Ellen Friedman of Asheville, Brenda F. Fitz and her husband, Larry of Columbus, NC and Jamie F. Stewart and her husband, Dan of Asheville; one grandson, Scott Smith and his wife, Amy; one great-granddaughter, Kyndall Smith and his former wife, Janet White of Hendersonville.
