



## Kenneth Robert Heinemann

January 6, 1940 - July 9, 2022

Kenneth Robert Heinemann, of Asheville, NC, passed away July 9, 2022, at CarePartners Hospice Solace Center after bravely fighting the effects of a stroke he suffered in 2017. He was 82 years old.

He was born and raised in Daytona Beach, Florida, and he had been a resident of Asheville for 37 years. He was the son of the late Robert E. Heinemann and Romilda Finley Heinemann, and he is preceded in death by 2 brothers, Nelson Heinemann and Mark Heinemann.

He served in the US Army and was a graduate of Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. He was a self-employed photographer and investor. In his youth, he pursued and competed in many forms of racing. He loved running track, racing cars, boats, canoes, and kayaks. Since moving to Asheville, his greatest joy has been hiking through the mountains with his wife, and, together, photographing the landscapes of Western North Carolina.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 56 years, Carla A. Heinemann; a son, Keith R. Heinemann of Asheville; a daughter, Julia C. Williams of Waynesville and 6 grandchildren.
