Lawrence P. "Larry" Carter, age 90, died Wednesday, September 17, 2008 at J. F. Keever Jr. Solace Center in Asheville, NC. He was born March 17, 1918. A native of Detroit, he was the son of the late George and Helen (Fredette) Carter.

Formerly of Ferndale, Berkley and Royal Oak, Michigan, Mr. Carter was an active member of St. Barnabas Catholic Church, in Arden, since his move to North Carolina in 1980.
