Logan T. Garrison, 31, of Asheville, NC passed away Sunday, September 11, 2011. Born December 23, 1979 in Greenville, NC, Logan grew up in Winston-Salem, NC.

She was a graduate of Mt. Tabor High School in Winston-Salem and she earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts in furniture design from the Savannah College of Art and Design in Savannah, GA. Just recently, she completed an associate's degree in medical sonography at Asheville-Buncombe Technical College and was a registered diagnostic medical sonographer.

As a multitalented artist, Logan was recognized with numerous awards for her artwork through the years. However, she found her greatest joy in the creative process and in sharing her creations generously with her family and her wide circle of friends.

She is survived by her parents, Drs. Raymond S. and Donna S. Garrison of Winston-Salem; grandmother, Juanita T. Southers of Mt. Holly; sister, Dr. Hilary S. Garrison, brother-in-law, Dr. Daniel P. Knechtel and niece, Elaine R. Knechtel all of Asheville; uncle, James R. Garrison, Sr., and his wife, Jane of Savannah; three cousins, James R. 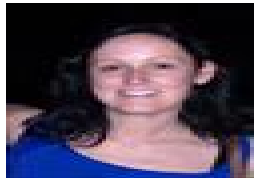
