Mae J. Long, 95, of Asheville passed away at her home on Thursday April 24, 2014. She was a native of Taylors, South Carolina, who resided in Asheville from 1950 to 1972 and again from 1984 until her death. Mae was a member of First Baptist Church for her entire residency in Asheville and belonged to the Dorcas Sunday School Class there until her death, whose members she cherished among her many friends.

In addition to visiting with family and friends, Mae enjoyed reading, bridge, making biscuits, and working at the polls on election days, which she only gave up after a hip operation at age 85.
