Maggie Hilemon Meador, 93, of the Brian Center Health and Rehabilitation Center of Weaverville, died peacefully, April 23, 2014, at St. Joseph Campus of Mission Hospital.

A native of Yancey County, Maggie moved to Asheville after caring for her parents until their deaths. She trained and became a licensed cosmetologist, retiring at age 76 after more than 40 years in her profession. She was of the Christian Faith.
