Malcolm F. Arthur, 89, of Asheville, died on Monday June 13, 2016 at The Oaks of Sweeten Creek. He is preceded in death by his wife of 60 years Kathryn "Kitty" Arthur who died on December 8, 2006.

A native of Buncombe County, Mr. Arthur was a son of the late W.H. and M Arthur of Asheville. He was a graduate of Lee Edwards High School and attended 2 years at Davidson College in Davidson, NC. He proudly served in the United States Army during World War II in the Japanese theater.

After returning to Asheville from the war, Mr. Arthur married his High School sweetheart "Kitty". He then worked for the family business, W.H. Arthur Company until he retired in 1988. He was also a founding member of Grace Presbyterian Church in North Asheville. Mr. Arthur was an avid hunter, golfer, bowler and traveler.
