



Margaret "Peggy" Adams

Margaret Ann Adams, lovingly known as Peggy or Peg, passed away peacefully at home in North Asheville on July 4th, 2025, surrounded by her devoted and adoring husband of 70 years, Bob Adams, and their five children: Michael, David, Anita, Mark, and Richard. She was preceded in death by their beloved daughter, Roxane, in 1978.

Peg and Bob were married on August 1, 1955. Together, they built a life centered on family, faith, and love raising six children, managing a busy household, and celebrating every moment with laughter, family time and home-cooked meals. She loved dancing, playing cards and all sports, especially golf and the Atlanta Braves! Peg's grace, kindness, and quiet strength were the heart of their home.

She kept our home and family running so smoothly and effortlessly perhaps never fully realizing just how deeply she impacted the lives around her. Peg was born on August 27, 1931, and raised in Birmingham, Alabama. She graduated from Phillips High School in 1950. She dedicated herself to being a loving wife, a devoted mother, and a constant, comforting presence to her family.

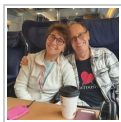

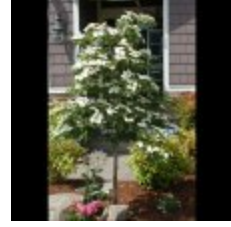
