Margaret "Maggie" McCants aged 93 years, of Asheville, North Carolina, passed away peacefully due to complications of COVID-19 on the evening of Sunday, January 17, 2021.

Maggie was born in Asheville, NC on June 15, 1927. She is preceded in death by her parents William McCants and Margaret McCants. Maggie is survived by her niece, Carol McCants of Raleigh, NC.

Maggie attended David Miller High School, Asheville, NC and graduated from Flora MacDonald College in Red Springs, North Carolina with a bachelor's degree.
