Martha Rumbough Waterman, 99, of Asheville died Wednesday, March 6, 2013. A native of Asheville, she was preceded in death by her husband, Robert D. Waterman in 1977.

Mrs. Waterman was a 1936 graduate of Wellesley College. She was a member of The Junior League of Asheville, AAUW and Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church.
