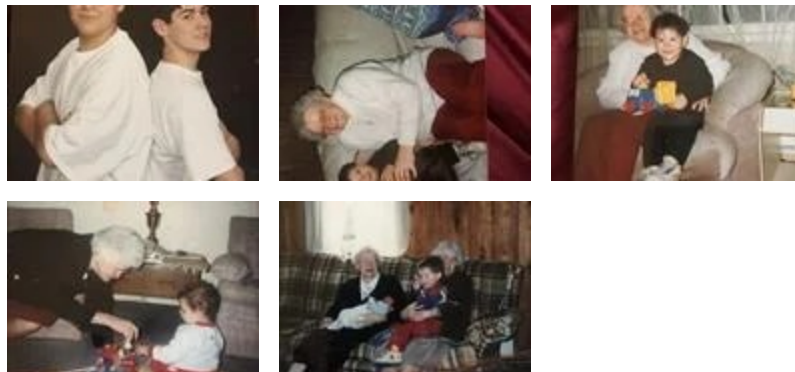

It's hard to believe Matt could be here one day and gone the next. His life made a positive impression on me and I will always remember him.

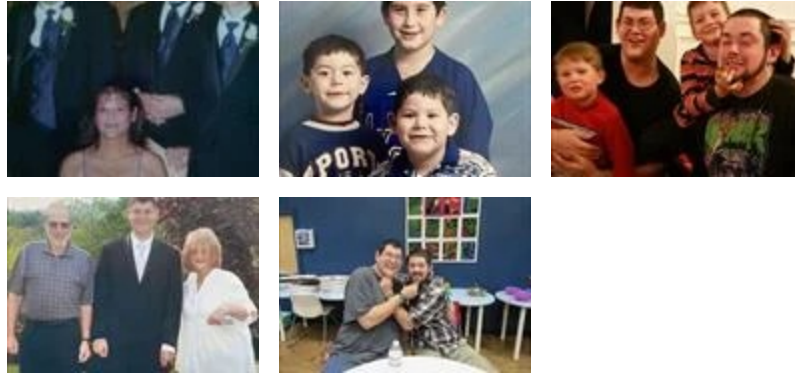
