



## Ms. Nancy Marlowe

Nancy Marlowe died on Wednesday, June 28, 2017 at the John F. Keever, Jr. Solace Center. She was a journalist, writer and editor and author of the book, *The Legacy of Mission Hospital, 120 Years of Caring*. She was human-interest columnist, reporter/writer and features editor of *The Asheville Times* and *The Asheville Citizen-Times*.

Health and medical writing was her special interest and she won the American College of Radiology top national honor for a feature on radiation oncology.

Following retirement, she wrote extensively for Mission Hospital. She also served as a volunteer, a member of the Ethics Committee and the Cancer Institutional Review Board at Mission.

Marlowe was born in Champaign-Urbana, IL, and grew up in Florida. She began her writing career at *The Lakeland Ledger*, a New York Times newspaper. She became a writer for the Florida State News Bureau, the tourism and industrial development promotional arm of the State of Florida. During this time, her writing appeared in *Parade* and *Southern Living* magazines and she served as a speechwriter for the governor of Florida.

She came to Asheville in 1972 and was employed by the *Citizen-Times* until retirement in 1997.

She served on the Buncombe County Public Library Board, the Board of Visitors of Warren Wilson College and the boards of civic organizations.

Marlowe was an active member of The Cathedral of All Souls. She organized the church's annual Thanksgiving potluck.

A sister, Dolores Edwards of Oldsmar, FL, and a brother, Frederick Jarrett of Douglasville, GA, survive her.

A memorial service will be held at 4:00pm on Thursday, July 6, 2017 at The Cathedral of All Souls with Rev. Thomas Murphy officiating.
