June 4, 1929 - May 2, 2011

Pat Richardson, a resident of Brooks-Howell Home died May 2, 2011, at a local hospital. She was born June 4, 1929, to Clarence and Ethel (Hargrave) Richardson in Indianapolis, but grew up primarily in Chicago.

She graduated from DePauw University in 1951, and was consecrated as a missionary with the Methodist Church in 1954. She later obtained a Master's Degree in Christian Education at Garrett Biblical Seminary.

Pat served as a missionary and pastor in Argentina for more than 43 years and was appointed the first female superintendent in the Argentine church.

She became a resident of Brooks-Howell Home in 1997. She was Vice President of the Brooks-Howell Residents' Council and volunteered at ABCCM Medical Ministry. She attended Asbury Memorial United Methodist Church.

She is survived by a brother James Richardson and wife Diane of Glen Ellyn, IL.

A memorial service will be held Wednesday, May 4, 2011, at 10 am in the Memorial Chapel at Brooks-Howell with Rev. Lisa Hartzog Hannah and Rev. Don Turman officiating.
