



## Col. Robert "Bob" Plummer Stewart

May 12, 1916 - November 22, 2005

ARDEN - Col. (Ret.) Robert "Bob" Plummer Stewart, 89, of Arden, died on Tuesday, Nov. 22, 2005, at Mission Hospitals, St. Joseph campus. A native of Charlotte, he was a son of the late Plummer and Annie Harrell Stewart. A longtime resident of the Asheville area, Mr. Stewart obtained his bachelor's degree from Duke University and his law degree from the University of Michigan Law School. A retired Colonel with the United States Army, he served in the 30th Infantry Division in World War II. Robert fought in three major battles including Normandy and the Battle of the Bulge. He also served as a legal aide for Judge Parker at the Nuremburg Trials, compiling evidence against Nazi war criminals.

Robert retired as a corporate attorney from Ecusta Paper Corp. in Pisgah Forest. He was an honorable and modest man of integrity and faith, who will always be loved and cherished by his family and all who knew him.

Robert is survived by his wife of 57 years, Helen O'Neal Stewart; three sons, Michael O. Stewart and his wife, Susan, of Rutherfordton, Stephen P. Stewart and his wife, Luciene, of Weaverville and David G. Stewart and his wife, Debbie, of Franklin; daughter, Helen A. Stewart of Oak Island; seven grandchildren, Bobby, Leigh Anna, Michelle, Benjamin, Rachel, Stefan and Lara Stewart; and a great-granddaughter, Scarlett Stewart.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. on Sunday in the chapel of Morris Funeral Home, 304 Merrimon Ave., Asheville, with Pastor Terry Brooks officiating.
