



Mr. Roland Theriault

May 21, 1933 - December 28, 2017

Roland Theriault, 84, of Asheville died December 28, 2017. Born in Caribou, Maine, he was the son of the late Edward and Irene O'Clair Theriault. He was also preceded in death by his brother, Gerald.

Mr. Theriault honorably served his country as a radio operator in the United States Navy during the Korean conflict. After being discharged from the Navy, he received a business degree from Bryant College in Providence, R.I. and master's degree in business administration from Northeastern University. He also attended the Graduate School for Urban Affairs at Boston University. He had successful careers as Chamber of Commerce Presidents and eventually changed to managing industrial development corporations in Rhode Island and Ohio. Their main function was to assist in the formation of new companies and to create new jobs. After his retirement 23 years ago, he relocated to Asheville, North Carolina.

His survivors include his wife of fifty-eight years, Dolores "Dolly" Theriault; daughters and sons-in-law: Karen and Ralph Gallo and Patricia and Edward Brown; sister-in law: Judy Bartlett Theriault and nieces and nephews.

Private interment was held at the Western Carolina State Veterans Cemetery.
