



Mr. Roy L. Dalman

February 2, 1937 - August 27, 2010

Roy Leonard Dalman of Asheville passed away Friday night at CarePartners Hospice after a long and valiant battle with cancer.

Roy was born February 2, 1937 in Greenwich, CT. He graduated from Greenwich High School and from Westchester Community College with a degree in Liberal Arts. A carpenter by trade, later a project manager and building estimator, Roy practiced his skills in Fairfield County, CT and Westchester County, NY and was a lifelong member of the Connecticut Carpenters Union. An avid hobbyist, he collected stamps and coins, painted in oils, built stained-glass, among many other interests. The son of Swedish immigrants, Roy also celebrated his Swedish heritage throughout his life. A lifelong resident of Greenwich, CT, Roy retired to Asheville in 2002.

Roy is survived by his wife of 42 years, Thomasina; a son and daughter-in-law Bob and Peggy Dalman and their two children, Mari and Kira, all of Asheville; and a granddaughter and her husband, Kristina and Matthew Harding of Winston-Salem. Roy is preceded in death by his daughter, Kim L. Nicholas also of Winston-Salem, and by his parents, Robert and Anna Dalman.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, September 1, 2010, in the Chapel of Morris Funeral Home, with the Rev. Christopher Webb officiating. The family will receive friends from 5 to 7 p.m., Tuesday, August 31, 2010, at Morris Funeral Home, 304 Merrimon Avenue. The burial will immediately follow at Riverside Cemetery and friends and family are then invited to a reception at the family home.
