Roy Dewey McAlister, age 77, passed away on Wednesday, August 31, 2016, at Mission Hospital. A native of Anderson, S. C. , he was the son of the late Roy Dewey McAlister and Mary Junkins McAlister. He was the youngest of 10 children.

Roy graduated from the University of South Carolina and attended Southeastern Baptist Seminary. After many years in banking he retired as branch manager of Nations Bank. A devoted Christian and a 50-year member of First Baptist Church of Asheville, he loved his family. He enjoyed being outdoors and was an avid runner.
