Sandra Farnam Sellers, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend, passed away peacefully at her home in Asheville after a courageous battle with ALS. She was born on May 7, 1949, and lived a life marked by deep faith, creativity, service, and love for her family and community.

Sandy was married to the love of her life, Danny Sellers, for 47 devoted years. Together they built a family grounded in grace and resilience. She was preceded in death by her parents, Barbara and Ellery Farnam; her children Alexandra and Preston; her grandson Kaydon Sellers, whom she held forever in her heart.

She is survived by her son, Morgan Sellers, and his wife, Jessie, their three daughters, Emerson, Mary Margaret, and Olivia, who were a constant light in her life.

Sandy is also survived by her sisters, Patty Brent and her husband Terrell, and Carole Cooper.
